The Government of Canada recently passed legislation to designate September 30 as a National Day for Truth and Reconciliation to "honour Survivors, their families, and communities, and ensure that public commemoration of the history and legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process."

To help create awareness amongst staff and our members, Kingston Community Credit Union will be observing the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.
